

In addition, many of these colors are also available with food-contact approval. Keystone can provide these fibers in a range of sizes and can also custom match most colors. The Granite Plus line has minimum volume requirements, so please contact your local sales representative for further details.

PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS

Denier — This is the property which determines the thickness of the fiber. The higher the value the thicker the fiber. The standard denier is 3 except where noted. Available denier range is 3, 5, 8, 18, and 25.

Length — The length, in inches, to which the fiber is cut. The tolerance is +/- 0.005" of the specified value. The fibers can be cut from 0.015" to 0.25". A small denier at a long length is generally not recommended. Contact your Keystone Sales Representative for further information.
